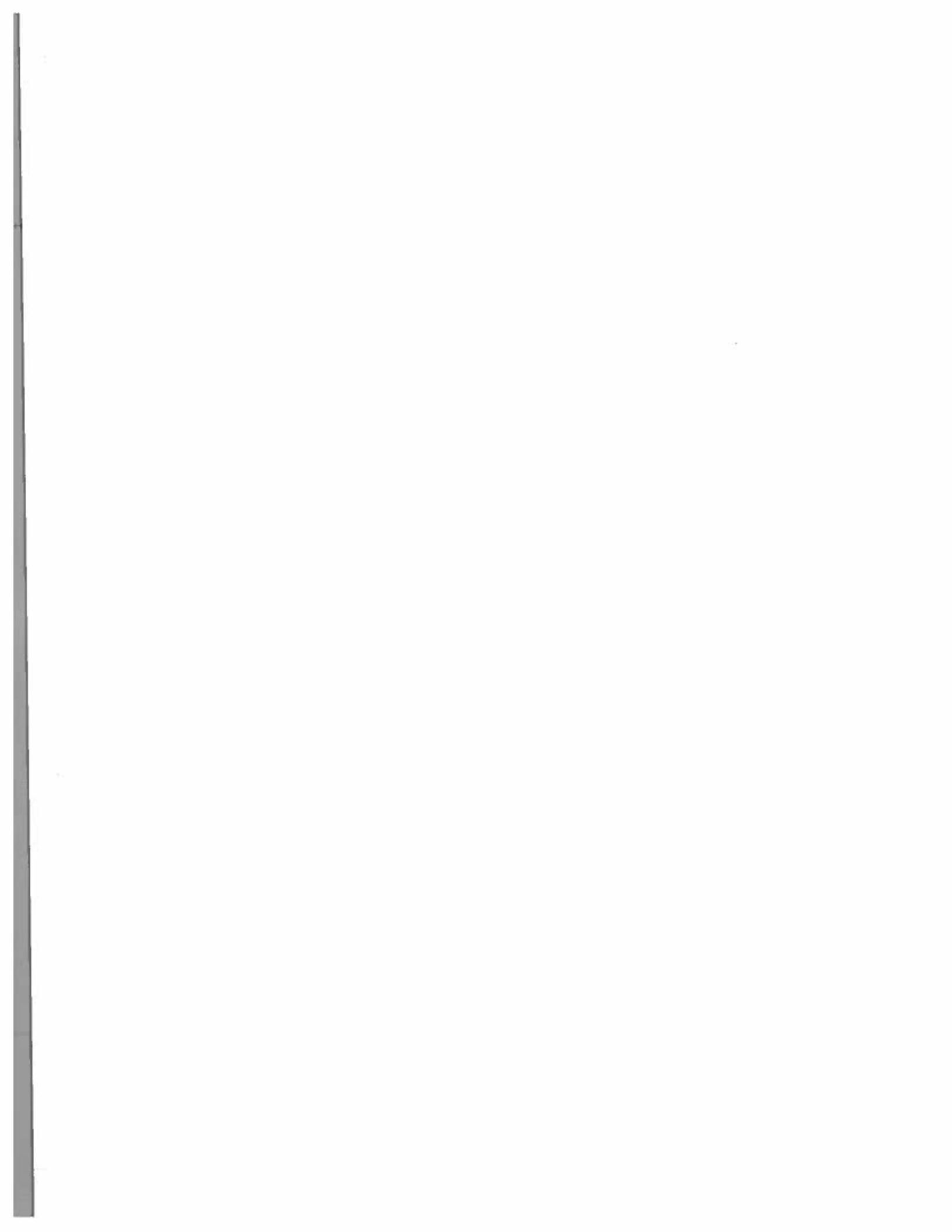

Keep getting faster

Devitt, Stafford win again; St. Paul's, St. Joseph's repeat in team category

It would be easy to dismiss the 33rd Round Table Run as an instant-replay of another high school cross country meet held last weekend at Highland Road Park.

The top teams and individuals also took top honors at St. Michael the Archangel's Bayou Boogie Classic.

A series of fast three-mile times helped set apart the annual meet hosted at Highland by Episcopal. ➤ Race results. 15C

"I tried to go faster the second mile and separate myself from the pack," Catholic High's Cole Stafford said. "That's really all I thought about."

Both Stafford and Christian Life Academy's Anna Katherine Devitt got the separation they needed during the first two miles of their respective three-mile varsity races.

Stafford posted a winning time of 15 minutes, 29 seconds, which was 15 seconds better than his winning time a week earlier.

"I tried to work through the whole race," Devitt said. "Whenever I started to feel a little tight, instead of letting up, I pushed myself harder."

Devitt's winning time of 18:29 was 24 seconds faster than her Sept. 10 mark.

The first nine boys runners all finished in less than 16 minutes, a feat that typically doesn't happen until late in the season.

Episcopal's Christian Johnson edged Neal Fitzpatrick, of Jesuit-New Orleans, for the No. 2 spot. Both runners finished in 15:32.

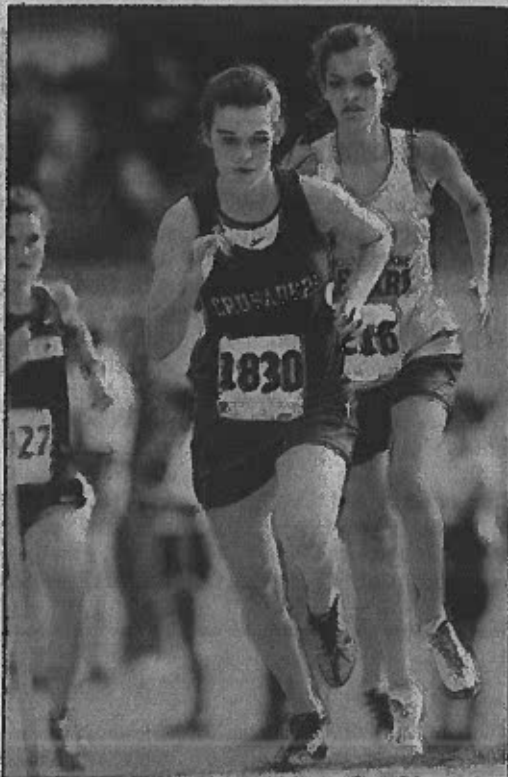
Devitt and runner-up Mallory Robichaux, of Menard-Alexandria (18:45) finished under 19 minutes. The top 13 runners finished below 20 minutes. Ellen Barkmeyer, of Dominican-New Orleans (19:09) was third.

The repeat team champions, St. Joseph's Academy and St. Paul's, also set a furious pace for the second straight week.

Fourth-place finisher Andree Laville (19:18) finished a second ahead of teammate Cassidy Noto as the Redstickers placed four runners in the top 15 and seven in the top 20.

SJA finished with 38 points, Dominican (50), Menard (123) and St. Thomas Aquinas (172) followed in a girls field that included 19 full teams.

"I've got some gamers in this group," St. Joseph's coach Sam Young said. "Before we ran I told them to think about Thursday's LSU (at Mississippi State) football game."

"LSU didn't start winning until the third quarter. This race was like that. It was great competition, and the race was won in the third mile."

Covington-based St. Paul's placed three runners in the top 10 and four in the top 15 to finish with the low boys total of 50 points. Host Episcopal (83) was followed by Catholic and Hammond's St. Thomas Aquinas both with 92.

The Bears took third over STA based on the finish of their No. 6 runner. The meet featured 29 full boys teams.

"The thing we talked about was trying to get better every week, and I think we did that," St. Paul's coach Terry Chatham said. "We want to continue to improve and more than anything else, just be consistent."

Other local girls in the top 10 were Parkview Baptist's Morgan Schuetz (sixth, 19:24) and Baker's Dynasty Williams (eighth, 19:38).

Kraemer Jackson, who took fourth in 15:37, was the top finisher for St. Paul's. Scott Wheat (eighth, 15:54) led STA.

Freshman Mallory Robichaux of Holy Savior Menard is a 4.0 student, she is on the student council and an outfielder on the school softball team, as well as being a dancer, but she has been making headlines recently as a cross country runner.

Classes 5A to 3A to compete for titles Monday

A season that began 10 weeks ago all comes down to two days for local teams eyeing the ultimate prize.

The Louisiana High School Athletic Association's State Cross Country Meet begins on Monday in Natchitoches with teams in Classes 5A to 3A set to compete.

Action at Northwestern State's Walter Ledet Track Complex concludes Tuesday with races for Classes 2A to C. Races begin at 11 a.m. Monday and 10 a.m. on Tuesday.

"Cross country is a simple sport when you get right down to it," St. Joseph's Academy coach Sam Young said. "The way to keep your point total down is by passing as many people as you can."

"I think our top runners match up pretty well with the top three from Dominican, and I believe our depth is good. I've told my girls that if they see someone from Dominican, Mandeville or Fontainebleau, they need to try and pass them."

The Redstickers seek their third Class 5A girls title in four years on Monday and should again battle Dominican-New Orleans, the team they edged by 10 points a year ago.

SJA and Episcopal were the only Baton Rouge schools to win titles in 2010. The Episcopal boys and girls swept the 2A titles for the second straight year. Three other boys teams, Catholic High (5A), West Feliciana (3A) and Ascension Catholic (1A), were runners-up. Both St. Michael the Archangel teams were third in 4A.

A new year brings new challenges. Catholic got edged by Jesuit-New Orleans by three points in last year's title chase. Top-ranked St. Paul's-Covington and Brother Martin-New Orleans are among the teams the Bears will face.

Episcopal has won the last 15 Class 2A boys titles but figures to face its stiffest challenge in years from Hammond's St. Thomas Aquinas. Meanwhile, Menard-Alexandria tops a deep 2A girls field that includes five

to six teams in contention for the top two spots.

"I think its going to be a great meet," Catholic coach Pete Boudreaux said. "We've run against St. Paul's, Brother Martin and Jesuit all year. We've gotten a lot better during the season, and they've all gotten better, too. Some of the north Louisiana teams will factor in. I'm anxious to see how our guys do."

Two of the top classifications will have new champions because of classification changes. Both 2010 3A champions, Sacred Heart-New Orleans girls (3A to 2A) and Holy Cross-New Orleans boys (3A to 4A), have moved on. So has last year's 4A boys champion Parkway (4A to 5A).

"We're a team that really has gotten better through the year," St. Michael coach Neil Borel said. "Our boys started with a group of above-average guys without a lot of experience, and they've improved. Our girls group is young, and they continue to improve."

"We've seen St. Thomas More. But we're a little bit of a disadvantage because we haven't seen Archbishop Shaw, Holy Cross or Cabrini that much. We can win with our one through seven runners giving us the best they have."

The Episcopal girls are part of a group of 2A contenders bunched behind Menard. The list also includes Sacred Heart-NO, Newman-New Orleans, Louise McGehee-New Orleans

Robichaux, Menard win Class 2A titles

Freshman Mallory Robichaux rallied to win the Class 2A individual championship Tuesday and lead her Holy Savior Menard team to the Class 2A team title at the LHSAA Cross Country Championships at Northwestern State.

It was the seventh state championship for Menard's girls and the first since 2000, when the Lady Eagles won the second of back-to-back titles, then in Class 1A.

"I'm a little bit speechless," said longtime Menard coach Wally Smith, who has also guided Menard's girls to seven state runner-up awards. "We had one girl (Lindsay Vaughn) on crutches with a hip problem three days ago and another (Meg Morrison) who has missed three or four races this season with hip problems.

"To win Class 2A, only the 5A winner could be prouder," added Smith, whose team ranked fifth in the state composite rankings entering the meet. "No class but 5A is tougher."

Robichaux trailed Hailey Hesterman of Calvary Baptist by eight seconds at the 2-mile mark on the 3-mile course that finishes at the Walter Ledet track, but she won the race handily with a time of 18 minutes, 46 seconds, while Hesterman finished second at 18:59.

Robichaux took the lead with less than a half-mile to go, finishing the final lap around the Walter Ledet track to wild cheers from Menard fans.

"I was really hurting and my legs were burning," said Robichaux, "but as soon as I hit the track, I started sprinting and pushed as hard as I could 'til I finished."

"I'm really proud of Mallory for finally achieving her goal," said Hesterman, who had beaten Robichaux twice this season. "After the 2-mile mark I started feeling kind of fatigued. It crushed my spirit a little bit when she took the lead, but I let my God carry me the rest of the way."

A team's cross country score is based on the five best runners' finishes, and each of Menard's top five runners were among the top 22 finishers, with the best scores starting with the fewest points (one point for 1st, two for 2nd, etc., and unattached runners are not scored). Freshman Rachel Engels-

man was 12th, sophomore Vaughn, 15th; sophomore Mallory Bartow, 17th, and junior Morrison, 22nd.

Menard, which has no seniors and one junior among its top seven runners, won the 17-team competition with 59 points, followed by Episcopal of Baton Rouge (70) and Sacred Heart of New Orleans (73). Rosepine of Vernon Parish finished 10th (297).

Some of the Menard runners celebrated the championship by rolling on the track's infield grass after the trophy presentation.

The Menard boys placed seventh (186) among 20 Class 2A teams, with Episcopal winning its 16th straight title and 25th in the last 27 years with 37 points. Christian Johnson, the runner-up at 15:54 to Lakeside's Enrique Soto (15:41), paced Episcopal. Senior Isaac Eilts, who joined senior teammate Andrew Lemoine as cross country academic all-state honorees with 4.0 averages, was Menard's top boys runner with a 19th place time of 17:50. Menard had four Eagles in the top 50 among 135 runners.
